Details Announced for Boca West CC's \$50M Renovation

The project at the Boca Raton, Fla. club, slated for completion in December 2016, will create a new Golf and Activities building that will include a Sports Bar restaurant with a New York street-scene backdrop and 30 high-def TVs, along with a 5,000-sq. ft. Golf Shoppe and activities ballroom.

Details have been announced for the \$50 million renovation at Boca West Country Club in Boca Raton, Fla. that is part of the Akoya project, which also includes a luxury condominium, that was announced last month (<http://clubandresortbusiness.com/2014/06/26/boca-west-cc-announces-50m-clubhouse-addition/>).

The summertime demolition project that will lead to the buildout of Boca West's new Golf and Activities Center kicked off on July 20, the club reported. During the construction, members will continue to have access to the club's restaurants and services in its recently renovated Spa and Fitness Center.

The new Golf and Activities building, which is slated for completion in December 2016, will include these features, Boca West CC reported:

Restaurant Gallery. An upscale gallery ambience will lead guests to the club's Signature restaurant, where panoramic views will be featured, along with a 2,000-bottle wine cellar and piano bar. The highly anticipated Sports Bar restaurant will showcase an outdoor terrace, an exciting New York street scene backdrop, plus a deli and dynamic open kitchen. The Sports Bar, with its interior video walls that will integrate 30 high-definition, big-screen TVs, will be ideal for viewing Sunday football and more.

Porte-cochere. The new and improved multi-lane valet and bag drop will allow member to receive personalized service whether dining in one of the restaurants, heading out to play golf or attending one of the many cultural arts events held in the ballroom.

Golf Shoppe at Boca West. The new Golf Shoppe will feature 5,000-sq.-ft. of merchandise, including fashion-forward golf and sports apparel plus everyday wear, and the latest in golf clubs, tennis rackets and pro accessories.

Activities Ballroom. The new blueprint provides state-of-the-art technology for all types of presentations, formal and relaxed, with flexibility provide by a divider concept. The ballroom will be used to accommodate the club's ongoing cultural arts programs across three rooms, or as a large single ballroom.

Locker Rooms. Luxurious men and women's locker rooms have been reimagined with spacious facilities fully equipped with upscale amenities and full-sized lockers and showers. Handsome lounges and card rooms will have all the finer touches.

"The new Golf and Activities Center will complement the tremendous golf and tennis programs currently at Boca West," said Jay DiPietro, CCM, the club's President/COO/General Manager. "During the renovation there will be no interruption to the first-rate services that our members and guests are accustomed to, including access to our restaurants, golf courses, tennis, spa and fitness center.

"Our members enjoy upscale amenities, destination restaurants, world-class golf courses and pro-worthy tennis in a wonderful setting," added DiPietro. "The new Golf and Activities Building continues that legacy."
